This year-long Fellowship is designed for students who show a capacity and potential to develop and evolve as leaders and who have a meaningful and rooted connection in a community anywhere in the world.

The Fellowship Experience

This post-graduate program is delivered through a hybrid education model, underpinned by a strengths-based, participant-focused approach, technical expertise, and a flexible learning agenda. Additional dedicated supports are integrated throughout the program to optimize participant learning and growth.

Each Pathy Fellowship cohort will participate in the following program phases:



Foundations for Community Change is an intensive experiential learning component hosted at Coady Institute. During this training, Fellows explore their personal and professional development goals, establish rich, dynamic bonds within their cohort, and learn about topics such as participatory community engagement and leadership principles, initiative planning and management, strengths-based approaches and fund development.



During the **Transition Phase**, Fellows return home and further develop their initiatives based on learning from program training. Transition Phase includes regular check-ins with peers and program staff, along with further distance-based learning and planning before beginning the Community Phase.



An extended **Community Phase** makes up the majority of the Fellowship timeline. During this phase, Fellows will work in and with their identified communities to implement their initiative. Fellows also receive ongoing dedicated support and distance learning from program staff, their mentors, and their peers.



The **Debriefing** is the final component of the program, where Fellows will evaluate personal and professional growth, outcomes from the community phase, and identify next steps. Fellows will celebrate their Fellowship year and complete a visioning of possibilities in their journey as changemakers.
